STUDENTS Open studio sessions are provided for pottery & painting class students as part of the class tuition for all CAPS classes, JCC classes, and BOCES classes. The open studio sessions are to be used only during the time of a student's enrolled status.

INDEPENDENT OPEN STUDIO PROGRAM Open studio sessions are also for registered Independent Open Studio participants. For complete details, please refer to the Independent Open Studio Program guidelines available in the studio.

CLAY If you are enrolled in a CAPS class, clay used during open studio sessions *is not* included as part of your class tuition. CAPS custom-blend clay will be available to purchase to use during open studio time priced at \$1 per pound for enrolled students or \$2 per pound for Independent Open Studio registrants. The price of the CAPS clay includes glazing and firing. Independent Open Studio participants who bring their own clay will be charged a kiln fee. JCC & BOCES students will not be charged for clay used during open studio sessions and will use clay from a designated supply.

CUBBIES Claim one of the cubbies as your own and store your clay, tools, supplies, energy bars, works-in-progress, or whatever else that you can fit into 2160 cubic inches. Please mark your cubby with masking tape and write your name and class start date on the tape. Affix tape above the cubby space.

ETC... You should be able to work independently. All open studio participants are expected to clean their work area, tables, pottery wheels, and return tools and materials to storage areas. Drop in during posted open studio sessions – no reservations needed! Remember to sign in and out each time you attend open studio.

HELP Open studio sessions are monitored by volunteer assistants who will be in the studio to help participants with work area preparation, cleanup, and access to materials.
